There was a discussion on sending a delegate to attend the PSAC Triennial Convention April 2015 and also the need to help send someone to the BC Federation Convention at the end of November 2014. Voting to take place at the next Area Council Meeting to be held October 16, 2014

Discussed the upcoming Municipal elections and that there are currently only two candidates running for the position of the Mayor : Lynn Hall and Don Zurowski . Lynn has been endorsed by the North Central Labour Council. There are additional candidates running for the position of council that have also been endorsed by the NCLC that will be put on a poll card and distributed by the Canadian Labour Congress (these poll cards people can take with them to the voting station)

Parveen Deepak put motion forward to vote in favor and to support the resolutions being put forward to the PSAC triennial by the Winnipeg Area Council (9 resolutions in total), everyone had a chance to read them at the meeting)

The motion was seconded by Collette Green

All resolutions were accepted unanimously.

Parveen will be submitting them to the Regional Office on behalf of the Area Council.
