<u>Minutes</u>: Reviewed previous minutes September 23, 2018. Minor change In closing balance should have read \$1538.88 not \$1538.68. Moved by Linda, seconded by Kelly – all in favour.

**Financial**: Kelly reported on the financial. Opening balance as of September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 \$1538.88 Cheques cashed were \$25 for youth initiative, \$273.00 Social Justice Fund(coffee) - for a closing balance of 1240.88 as of October 31, 2018. Still uncashed is the cheque for \$50.39 for coffee grinders. Kelly moved the financial report, Linda seconded, and all were in favour

Motion for Kelly Megyesi to be reimbursed for the Kelowna Shelter Christmas dinner door prize in the amount of \$91.16 (two Christmas gift boxes, 2 coffee grinders, 4 bags of coffee). Linda moved and Jeanne seconded. All in favour.

<u>Migrant Workers</u>: Discussion on the migrant worker situation. The committee talked about issues within their local area. Talked about donating to the organization RAMA but it was felt that we would look at this more next season. Work on this initiative will be carried into 2019.

**<u>Projects</u>**: Maria-Luiza was lead on the Advent project scheduled for this month (calendars for 3 locations for children). Due to her unavailability we will not be able to complete this project in 2018. Linda suggested that we work on this throughout 2019 so that all is ready for next Christmas. Group was in agreement.

Other ideas were discussed. The committee agreed that we would support Indigenious Suicide prevention within our communities. Linda provided the link for the series
