How do the BC NDP and the BC Liberals stack up for working families?

	BC Liberal	BC NDP
Health care	Emergency room crisis continues. No plan to fix hallway medicine.	Has committed to strong health care and improved access to services.
Public sector bargaining	Imposed terms on teachers with Bill 22. Promising two more years of wage freeze.	Committed to free and fair collective bargaining for all public sector workers.
Skills training and apprenticeship	Dismantled BC's apprenticeship system. Far fewer young people are getting trades as a result.	Promises to fix BC's growing skills shortage, creating opportunities and jobs for young people.
Post-secondary education	Increased tuition fees and student debt, making BC amongst the least affordable jurisdictions in Canada.	Has committed to tackling student debt through needs-based grants for post-secondary students.
Affordability for working families	Froze wages for public sector and minimum wage workers for a decade. Imposed HST, Hydro and ICBC rate hikes.	Fought the HST and has called for fair taxes that ease the burden on working families.
