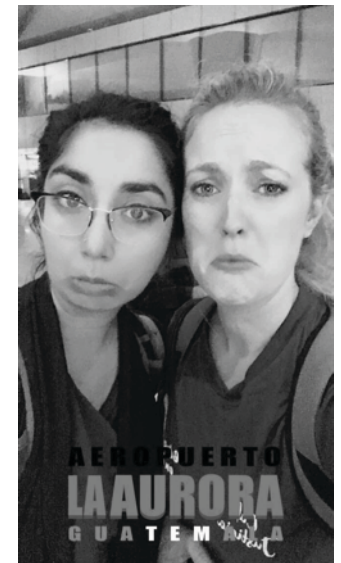
DAY 13
