#### **BC Forum**

Jamey turned the floor over to Sam Wiese to discuss the BC Forum which is an organization for union members over 50. It offers a voice for members over 50 as well as negotiating benefits for those members, such as extended health, dental and death benefits.

The BC Forum had their executive meeting on November 17, the membership currently stands at 2,049 which is very low, so Sam is out trying to push for more union members to join.

Also discussed at the executive meeting were the outcome of the Federal Election and the Syrian Refugee Crisis

Federal Election – a lot of discussion around the results. Although it wasn't the Orange Crush we had hoped for, NDP took 14 seats in BC, up from 12 and there are several BC members sitting in the shadow cabinet. Now we have to hold the Liberals to account.

Syrian Refugee Crisis – discussion around the negativity in the media and fearmongering since the Paris attacks. The BC Forum will be coming out with a positive statement on the crisis, including that we already have security measures in place and that we need to be sure that the funds are there to settle refugees properly
