Proportional Representation – presentation by Debbie Hubbard & Wayne Broughton, Fair Vote BC

Debbie and Wayne gave an informative presentation about the upcoming BC Referendum on proportional representation (see handouts attached), here are some key points:

- The referendum is taking place by mail-in ballot from October 22 to November 30, 2018.
- To participate, make sure you are a registered voter and your address is current: https://elections.bc.ca/register-to-vote/.
- If proportional representation is accepted, the voting system will be re-visited with another referendum after 2 general elections.
- The referendum consists of 2 questions, voters can answer one or the other or both (for example, a voter could vote for proportional representation but not choose which proportional representation voting system they prefer).
