### **Treasurer Report**

Aaron Chang is the new Treasurer. Aaron and Terri have submitted their information to the Credit Union to be the new signing officers. They will receive papers to finalize the process via email within 30 days. The term deposit is going to be moved over to the general account. For our Regional Allocation we were granted our full request of \$2000.00.

### **Provincial Election Funding**

The REVPs office is allocating funds of \$120/riding covered by the Area Councils. Our allocation for Political Action related to the Provincial Election will be \$3480.00.

### **MP Lobby**

As a result of the Area Council Summit we had decided to look into getting an MP to come and do lobby training with us, but ran into some problems contacting our targeted MPs. Jamey reached out to Jenny Kwan, but her constituency office wasn't fully set up and he has not received a reply as yet. Another member reached out to Joyce Murray, but again, no reply.

The Federal Budget has come out and we should be requesting meetings with our MPs.

Jamey has committed to following up with Jenny Kwan. Ron, Jamey and Todd will go to see Don Davies. Terri is in Jody Wilson Raybould's riding and will seek a meeting with her. Cheryl has committed to trying to get a meeting with Mark Strahl. Jamey is hoping that Shane will still be seeking a meeting with Hedy Fry, he committed to this at the last Area Council meeting. Ron will work on getting a meeting with Harjit Sajjan. Crystal Warner has said that CEIU members would like to go in groups to meet with the ministers.

The PSAC noted that there was a definite interest in lobbying expressed after the election. Initially, the PSAC wanted to focus on the budget, but now that the budget has come out the lobbying focus should continue but the talking points might change somewhat.

Monica U reported that the Area Councils on Vancouver Island and Fraser Valley East and West have started lobbying, but the North hasn't yet.

Jamey committed to approach Bob Jackson about possibility of claiming Loss of Salary for daytime meetings with MPs for members.

April 15 – National Fight for 15 Rally – Vancouver rally is taking place at Canada Place at 5 PM, there will be an appreciation event afterwards at Rogue. This event is being put on by the BCFed and the National day was initiated in BC.

April 16 – Grant's Law Sit-in at the Macs store on East Broadway. Macs is the site of the sit-in because they have been strongly involved in the push to water down the original Grant's Law legislation for people working alone. Will be from 8 PM-6AM.
