<u>Call to order:</u> Karolyn called the meeting to order at 1740.

Quorum: met

- Meeting called to order at 1740 by Karolyn Jones
- Kayla motions to approve agenda, Karolyn seconds: CARRIED
- Nancy motions to approve the November 2020 meeting minutes, Leanne seconds: CARRIED
- **Previous Business**: Dec 6 Vigil, Nancy has the floor. Nancy thanks Kim for her work on the power point and sends a shout out to Monica Urrutia and Patrick Bragg, and guest speakers Virginia Vaillancourt, Carissa Ropponen, and Marianne Alto.

It was the largest gathering for the Vigil at 110 of 200+ people who RSVP'd. We raised the most amount ever: \$3650 divided between the Transition House and Victoria Sexual Assault Clinic. This includes the VI Women's committee donation of \$500. Some non-PSAC unions donated directly to the groups.

Zoom allowed more people to attend in comfort of their own home no matter the weather.

Considerations for next year: continue the financial requests from other unions outside PSAC like the Nurses Union; early requests are the key to the success of the donations highlight that Zoom Coordinates to join the event must be requested; and remember to turn off the CHAT function as it encourages people to remain focused on the program.

Virginia stated that the families that she talked to from the murdered women at Ècole Polytechnique in Montreal are grateful the memorial is still being done.

A proclamation form the City of Victoria will be added to the minutes.

• **Budget**: Rough draft discussed and attached. Will add a line to budget ACTION ON SURVEY wrt the survey that was sent out to the PSAC members about what they wanted to see in their committees.

Dyan suggested adding an Honorarium to budget of \$25 per meeting not to exceed \$100 in calendar year. Will add it and see what the response is. Virginia stated that if honorarium is approved then a T4A must be issued as it is taxable income.

Monica noted that funds can be reallocated with the approval of the committee and subsequently submitted to the REVP Office if we don't use the amount we originally requested.

Leanne asks about the Operating Committee notebooks that were talked about at a previous meeting. Monica says there's an Electronic version available, but it requires some minimal revisions. <u>"NATIONAL DAY OF REMEMBRANCE</u> AND ACTION ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN"

- WHEREAS
 December 6, 2620, as the 31st anniversary of the 1989 Ecole Polytechnique Montreal massocre in which furthern female engineering students were singled out for their gender and were killed; and

 WHEREAS
 in 1991 Canado's Produment declared December 6th a National Day of Remembrance and Action on Violence Against Wanew, and
- WHEREAS the United Nations Secretory General Comparing Against Gander-Based Violence for 2030 is guided by the global theme "Orange the World: Fund. Respond, Provent, Collect?, recognizing that as the world retreated inside homes due to the locadown measures introduced to earb the COVID-19 pendemia, reports Monwel an elemining interease in the airwady existing pendemic of violence against women and a spike in domestic violence reporting, at exactly the time that services, including rule of law, leadth and shelters, are being diverted to address the pandemia, neurording to the fleetetary-General; and
- WHEREAS each year, communities across Canada commemorate December 6th to refluct on the tragedy of the Montreal Massacre and to remember the 14 women where lives were so bratally cut that;, and
- WHEREAS violence against women affects every commanity member in Victoria whether as a survivor of domestic or allow violence or as a family member, friend, neighbour, or co-worker of a survivor: and
- WHEREAS education and avareness are key to ending violence against women, and the Public Service Alliance of Conodo and its Victoria Regional Women's Committee have been organizing vigits and educational programs to raise awareness about violence against women since 2009; and
- WHEREAS the City of Victoria continues to work towards building a society in which everyone has the right to live in conditions of sofety, dignity, respect and peace.

NOW, THEREFORE 1 do hereby proclaim Shaday. December 6th, 2026 as "NATIONAL DAYOF REMEMBRANCE AND ACTION ON VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN" on the HOMELANDS of the Lekwangen speaking SONGHEES AND ESQUIMALT PEOPLE in the CITY OF VICTORIA, CAPITAL CITY of the PROVINCE of BRITISH COLUMBIA.
